Christmas charity bonus from £40K annual London Array Community Fund

- Four local charities receive Christmas funding boost
- Grants are in addition to 13 charities receiving up to £5,000 supporting five key areas:
 Environment, Children, Young People and Families, Elderly and Isolated, Employability, Skills and
 Enterprise and Vulnerable Adults

Since construction in early 2012, RWE-operated London Array has supported charities and community groups in the local area, thanks to the generous input from our shareholders, RWE Renewables, Boreas, Greencoat and Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company PJSC - Masdar.

New for this year is that London Array has worked with Kent Community Foundation who managed the applications and distributed the £40,000 fund on behalf of the wind farm.

Awards of up to £5,000 were made available for applicants working within one or more key areas: Environment, Children, Young People and Families, Elderly and Isolated, Employability, Skills and Enterprise and Vulnerable Adults. The first donations were awarded in August 2024 and are noted in the table below.

The Community Fund committee retained £4,000 from the August distribution so that we could support local charities over the Christmas and winter period. This gave the local London Array staff the opportunity to vote as to where the money was distributed. The following charities have received a share of £4,000:

- Age UK Thanet: Helping the elderly.
- RNLI: Saving lives at sea.
- Salvation Army Ramsgate: Daily drop-in for the homeless providing breakfast, clothing, washing facilities and advice.
- Thanet Food Link: Providing food to those in need.

In August, Dentaid, the Dental Charity which provides dental care for the homeless received £1,475 from the Community Fund. The funding was awarded to support a project to deliver six free mobile dental clinics alongside Thanet District Councils RISE (Rough Sleeper Intervention Support Empowerment) a newly established multi agency team working to support those who are sleeping rough and most in need of support.

Jill Harding from Dentaid said, "Our mobile dental units are fully equipped mobile dental surgeries on wheels. We offer our patients emergency pain relieving treatments, x-rays, scale and polish and restorative dental care. We support people experiencing homelessness by visiting hostels, drop-in centres, and soup kitchens and those who are insecurely housed or sleeping rough.

"We are very grateful to London Array Offshore Wind Farm Community Fund and the Kent Community Foundation team for supporting our important work in the community."

James Vause, London Array General Manager, is delighted: "We would like to thank Kent Community Foundation for taking over the administration of the fund and enabling ease of access to local groups to the monies.

"This fund is a voluntary commitment, created by London Array, to make a real difference to our local community. A panel including staff from London Array Wind Farm met to assess projects, presented by Kent Community Foundation and award grants. I am delighted that the monies are going to support local charities that in turn support the needs of local people."

Natalie Smith, Director of Grants and Impact and Deputy Chief Executive, Kent Community Foundation said, "It was clear from Dentaid's application how their services not only improve oral health outcomes and reduce dental-related complications but enhance overall wellbeing for the vulnerable. We presented the request for support to the London Array Offshore Wind Farm Community Fund, and they were delighted to award funding of £1,475 to support the mobile clinics in Thanet
