London Array Limited Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement 2025

London Array Limited ("the Company") operates an offshore wind farm in the Outer Thames Estuary situated midway between the Kent and Essex coastlines, more than 20 km (12 miles) from each shore which consists of 175 turbines with a generation capacity of 630MW, installed on the Long Sand and Kentish Knock banks and in the Knock Deep channel that lies between. London Array Limited is jointly owned by subsidiary companies of RWE AG, Schroeders Greencoat LLP, Masdar –and La Caisse de dépôt et placement du Québec (CDPQ).

The Company has appointed RWE Renewables UK Wind Services Limited to provide operational services under a Management Operation and Maintenance Agreement, energy management services under an Energy Management Services Agreement and management services under a Joint Venture Management Services Agreement.

The Company is committed to both the statutory requirements under the Modern Slavery Act 2015, and to acting with integrity in all its business dealings and relationships to have a zero tolerance approach to Modern Slavery. This is a position which it expects all of its suppliers to respect and adopt.

The Company has instructed RWE Renewables UK Wind Services Limited, to:

- (i) implement and enforce effective systems of controls to ensure that Modern Slavery is not taking place anywhere within either its or the Company's business or in any of its or the Company's supply chains; and
- (ii) ensure that where contracts are negotiated with third parties in the Company's name and on the Company's behalf that such contracts provide suitable provisions relating to the systems of control that such third parties are taking to ensure that Modern Slavery is not taking place within their business and supply chains.
